SANITATION SCALE-UP PROGRAM



PROVINCE OF SINDH US\$7 million leveraged from nutrition in 13 districts:

16 MILLION PEOPLE enabled to become ODF by 2017



PROVINCE OF PUNJAB US\$4 million program implemented by Province of Punjab impacting **9 MILLION PEOPLE** for ODF (13% population of the province)

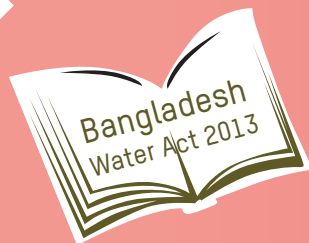

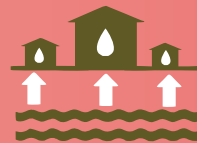
